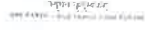

Kharagpur Homoeopathic Medical College and Hospital, At Kaushalya, P.O Kharagpur, Distt. Midnapore, West Bengal-721301. is functional since 1971 has applied for sanction of admission with intake capacity of 60 seats for undergraduate (BHMS) for the academic year 2024-25.

The College has submitted the Part 1 information in which the entire functional profile has been narrated. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board has examined the profile of the College as to whether the college fulfils the Minimum Essential Standards to be fulfilled as per the prevailing regulations under clause 28 of NCH Act 2020. Furthermore, few deficiencies had been noticed, which needed to be addressed and hence hearing was scheduled for 27.06.2024 at 10.00 A.M

On careful examination of all the documents submitted by the college authorities and explanation given by them for the shortfalls intimated to them via hearing letter following observations were made by the hearing committee:

Acquittance and attendance

- Form 16 of the teaching staff are not from the trace's portal.

Hospital details

- OPD Patients daily average is low 114.56 against requirement of 120 per day. On the day of hearing 60 patients were registered in OPD and the IPD had 08 patients which were admitted after 1.30 PM. Collegiate hospital should have sufficient no of patients to impart adequate clinical exposure to the medical college students and should make efforts to increase the OPD and IPD attendance of patients.

Demographic details of patients are not recorded on case sheets. Diagnosis and proper case taking is not done with follow-ups of the patients. Case records shall be maintained with detailed case history, complete case analysis, evaluation, repertorisation and justification of prescription on the caesheets and shall be made available in the Medical Record Room for academic purposes of students and follow up attendance of patients.

Miscellaneous

- Adhaar enabled biometric attendance system (AEBAS) – data not submitted. Same may be implemented within 30 days .
- Compliance with circular issued on CCTV surveillance system -college has not implemented

Considering the above observations and facilities available, Medical Assessment and Rating Board has decided to issue **Conditional Permission to Kharagpur Homoeopathic Medical College and Hospital, At Kaushalya, P.O Kharagpur, Distt. Midnapore West Bengal-721301 for continuing UG/(BHMS) course with intake capacity of 60 seats for the academic year 2024-25**

All deficiencies noticed shall be rectified within a period of one month and the compliance report shall be submitted for verification

All admissions shall be made for NEET qualified candidates only. Counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective Counseling Authority of State/ UT govt as designated by Central Government and counseling for the remaining 85 % seats or as the case may be conducted by the concerned counseling authority of the state/UT.

The category wise list of the selected candidates may be informed to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy after the process of admission is completed. Any admissions carried out other than NEET qualified students will not be approved by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board.

Permission to college will be withdrawn or denied in the subsequent year if college is found deficient in compliance to MSR 2013 anytime during the academic year.
